\*\*\*\*\* MEET THE SPEAKERS \*\*\*\*\*

**Cathie Osborne - Sequim WA** - I have collected bells on stamps for more than 35 years, and I am amazed at the topic's scope. I have been involved in the Strait Stamp Society since its beginning, and I am active in putting on the local show. I have served as a Federation representative for many years.

**Eric Bustad - Seattle WA** - I first collected stamps as a pre-teen, after receiving a starter collection kit for Christmas/Birthday. The collection mostly contained stamps brought home from work by my Father, after his stamp collecting boss had first pick. It was frustrating, as nearly none of these stamps matched the illustrations in my album. I eventually gave my collection to a younger brother.

I restarted while in college. I was working part time, and, so, had money to buy more interesting stamps. I decided to specialize in Germany area stamps, bought a set of Scott albums and a packet of 2000 different German stamps at the "Stamp Gallery" in Bellevue. I moved to New Jersey in 1976 and started attending stamp shows, and for awhile, the local stamp club (Hazlet Stamp Club). Around 1999, I joined the Collector's Club in New York City.

As half of my ancestry is half Norwegian, I decided to subscribe to the Norwegian stamps issued for the 1994 Winter Olympic games. That led me to start collecting Norway in addition to German area.

I returned to Seattle area in 2001, joining several local clubs and attending my first Moses Lake seminar a year or two later.

**Tim Bartshe - Golden CO** - I have been a stamp collector since the age of 5 and really did not put down the tongs even during high school and college. My interests first directed themselves towards British Africa and ultimately focused on the Boer Republics; Orange Free State and South African Republic (Transvaal), where they have remained for several years. First exhibiting in 1997, the experience led to multiple exhibiting projects both national and international garnering numerous national gold medals and grand awards and international large gold and gold medals. The exhibiting experience also was the impetus to becoming an accredited APS judge. This has culminated in becoming active in all aspects of judging AND exhibiting which includes immediate past president of the American Association of Philatelic Exhibitors and current member of the Committee on Accreditation of National Exhibitions and Judges (CANEJ), an APS function. As an avid trout fisherman for as long as a stamp collector, it would only make sense that my collecting interests would turn to trout which is the subject of a thematic exhibit and a collection of salmonids including SC 1079, the US wildlife conservation stamp which shows a salmon jumping. Further interests are various philatelic aspects of Guatemala, Ecuador, and Nicaragua. The greatest joy, however, in organized philately is the interaction with so many wonderful people who share the same passion of the grand hobby as I do.

**Larry Maddux - Vancouver WA** - I am President, Pacific Northwest Postal History Society, and a member of the Western Cover Society. I was awarded the Grand and President's Award at SOPEX exhibiting Oregon Postal History. I received the best Postal History exhibit at PIPEX.
